A sensitive architect with models of a hopeless situation depicted in the figure is a new direction for the transfer of information for the development of housing construction in Ukraine. Canvas: president-war-freedom-achieving an equilibrium with the people represented by representatives of different socio-systems.

A uniformed team is being created from representatives of various construction specialties for the initial form of movement of this team from America to Ukraine. In Ukraine, in different places will be created in the context of the monuments of the past up to 1,000 residential properties of the proposed orientation of the sensitivity of the Ukrainian people to the arrangement of their way of life, home (monuments, Ukraine). An example is a house drawing for a stone-themed facility in Vermont created by Sean Cummings (see Attachment 1). 









Map 3L. Numerical assessment of the categories from a bookmark: New Russia (LEFT PART)




System Dynamics Map revealing













System Dynamics Map revealing
the mechanism of terrorist formation in America for actions in America -PART II (A-M)










